

AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY DEPARTMENT OF CALIFORNIA Auxiliary Emergency Fund/Office of Emergency Services 2023-2024 Mid-Year Report

As a first time Department Chairman. I am humbled by the commitment all the Department program chairman devote to keeping our American Legion Auxiliary a viable and thriving organization. Thank you Madam President for allowing me to serve our organization.

As we all know it does take time to complete the information asked on the report forms. I would also like to thank all the Units and Districts AEF chairmen who sent in the reports.

The 2023-2024 AEF Mid-year reporting information was received from 15 Districts (52%) including 72 Units reporting activity and 50 Units reporting no activity.

Six Districts donated \$312.75 while 35 Units donated \$2599. There were five Districts in which the units cumulatively donated over \$100 and seven individual Units donating over \$100. I have to give a shout out to District 21 whose Units donated \$1355 in total with Unit 79 Riverside donating \$500 and Unit 574 Morrison Memorial \$650. Of note, given the devastation of the fire in Maui this year, there were two Units in District 26 that donated money to the Maui Relief Fund for the local American Legion Post. Unit 105 Redwood City donated \$100 and Unit 585 Lloyd J Tobey donated \$500. One Unit member in District 12, Unit 491 donated \$50 for Hawaii.

Thirty-one Units have a line item for AEF in their annual budget and seven Units discussed increasing their AEF budget. Two Districts and two Units held fundraisers. Thirty Units shared about the AEF program and twenty-two Units handed out AEF brochures. Six Units handed out AEF applications. There were two Emergency assistance and one Education assistance application submitted. Supplemental reports were received from District 2, Unit 92 and District 21, Unit 200.

District 2, Unit 92 - This was the first year Unit 92 funded AEF in their budget. They used the money raised from cleaning up a highway. They had one member take an application and they explained the process.

District 21, Unit 200 - Unit donated \$25 to AEF and participated in a fundraiser for a local child with cancer to help assist the family. This Unit has a nominal budget to assist any member of their Post 200 American Legion Family.

The supplemental reports and the statistical data are attached to this report.

Please go back and thank all your members for supporting the AEF and consider holding a Unit or District fundraiser specifically to support the AEF.
